27 The petition for writ of mandate on file in this matter having been considered, and
28 this Court having ordered that a peremptory writ of mandate issue, YOU ARE

COMMANDED:

1 1. Respondents shall not use credits to advance the minimum eligible parole
2 date of any inmate sentenced to an indeterminate term to a date earlier than authorized by
3 section 3046 of the Penal Code, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in sections 3043
4 through 3043.7 of title 15 of the California Code of Regulations.

5 2. Respondent Board of Parole Hearings shall not conduct an initial parole
6 hearing for any indeterminately sentenced inmate based on the minimum eligible parole
7 date more than one year before the minimum eligible parole date computed in accordance
8 with section 3046 of the Penal Code, without advancement of that date via credits not
9 authorized by that section.

10 3. Respondents California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and
11 Jeffrey Macomber shall not release any indeterminately sentenced inmate on parole based
12 on the minimum eligible parole date earlier than the minimum eligible parole date
13 computed in accordance with section 3046 of the Penal Code, without advancement of that
14 date via credits not authorized by that section.

15 YOU ARE FURTHER COMMANDED to make a return within sixty days of the
16 date of the order directing issuance of this writ indicating what steps you have taken to
17 comply with the writ.
